Note, St. Louis County Revised Ordinances 107.071 SLCRO, 107.400 SLCRO and 107.401 SLCRO are not applicable to the selection process for this contract. The consultant selected for this contract will be responsible for overall project management as well as tasks required for completion of the designs, which provides for Americans with Disabilities (ADA) improvements, the replacement of an existing single-span bridge, the addition of shared-use paths, and traffic signal upgrades/replacements. The selected consultant will act as the owner representative for all phases of the projects. The consultant project manager will be embedded within the SLCDOT both virtually and physically as necessary to successfully perform the required services. The projects in this solicitation all are located within an Environmental Justice (EJ) area.
