



## ORIENTEERING DEPARTMENT POLICY

### **PURPOSE:**

To allow the sport of orienteering in St. Louis County Parks.

### **POLICY:**

It is the policy of the St. Louis County Department of Parks and Recreation to allow orienteering activities not in conflict with other park uses.

### **PROCEDURE:**

#### **Orienteering Maps**

Orienteering maps for a number of the larger County Parks are produced by St. Louis Orienteering Club (see attached order form). You can visit their website to purchase maps on-line. The Parks Department does not provide orienteering maps.

#### **Facilities**

Orienteering is permitted in all parks, except Lone Elk and on the Veterans Memorial.

#### **Rules**

1. Temporary courses may be set up using markers that do not damage property or interfere with other activities. At the end of the event, it is the responsibility of the users to remove all markers.
2. Reservations are required for major competitions, night events and for groups of more than 25 persons involved in the orienteering activity by calling our Special Events Coordinator at 314-615-3871. Special Events fees will apply.
